We have been spoilt in some respects, by having such a good, informative, intuitive appointments system, set up by Kerrel Wills, in conjunction with Pro-Web.

Kerrel will be working hard to try and ensure that we still have the usability of our system, by exporting data from WTR into our system.

All members who completed 10 games last season will be receiving a new set of refereeing kit at the members meeting on 20th August. You will also receive a set of LSRUR Flags and a score card holder + score cards. The standard of the kit from Web Ellis is excellent and it will ensure all our members 'stand out' on the pitch! Wear it with pride.

Tom Brucciani, our training officer, has already set up a couple of pre-season training sessions, at Belgrave RFC and will be holding more sessions, as the season progresses. All members, at whatever stage in your refereeing career are all welcome and encouraged to attend these sessions; its never too late to learn.

As I've said before, LSRUR exists for its members. The committee work extremely hard to ensure that all members, receive the appointments commensurate with their grade, the opportunity to develop and to feel part of the Society, whatever your grade or role is. In turn this facilitates local rugby in Leicestershire, by providing the best officials we can to our clubs.

If this is not happening for you, please speak up; I am very approachable and would sooner hear of any problems/issues, good or bad, so that we can deal with them.

Personally, this season will be very different for me as, for the first time in 22 years, I will not be in the middle blowing the whistle.
